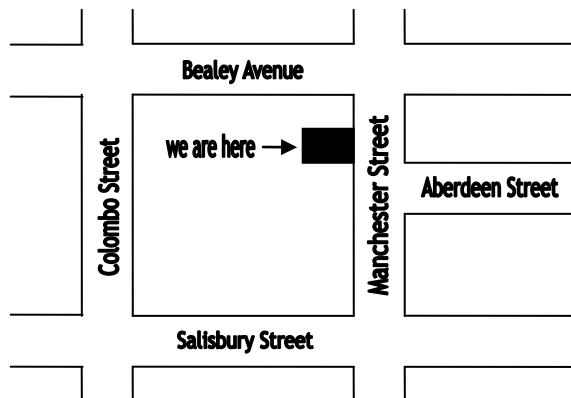

It's all about getting jobs

It is vitally important that your reason for training with us is to get a job and that you are prepared to do what it takes to get that job!

Throughout this programme, you will be shown the skills needed to find employment successfully. This support is continued following the programme, with help finding employment or the appropriate next education programme to further your career.

As a part of your training, you will be placed into the industry for work experience. Many gain employment from this work experience.

You finish WORKstart when you gain employment (a maximum of 26 weeks training). However this may be extended in some instances for Youth Training job seekers.



WORKstart is

- Practical hands-on training
- CV preparation or updating
- Work experience
- Career planning and job search
- Personal development to further enhance your skills for the workplace. You'll be able to develop essential attributes such as personal presentation, cultural and community awareness, time keeping, team work, dealing with stress and communicating in a working environment.

WORKstart is

- Literacy and numeracy support
- NZQA units and/or qualifications
- Opportunity to complete NCEA up to Level 2

What you could achieve

The Academy assists every job seeker to set learning goals and plan steps to gain employment. When in employment support is given to ensure the transition to earning and independence is smooth.

All unit standard based learning gained from this programme is recorded with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority. These achievements remain with you forever and can be added to at any time.

WORKstart Construction Skills includes

- Woodworking - which involves calculating job specifications, the use of appropriate equipment including hand tools, electric tools, band saws, planing machines, circular saw benches and sawing machines
- Construction - which involves preparing sketches and drawings and applying the principles of linear measurements to building calculations. Projects could include fences, decking, building on concrete piles or garden furniture
- Health & Safety - involving safely using equipment, first aid and OSH requirements

We'll do more than teach you about building things like fences and pergolas - we'll also sit down with you to determine the skills and attitudes you need to get working!

The WORKstart Construction Skills programme offers training in a wide range of skills that can lead you into employment in several areas, such as woodworking, carpentry, furniture making or construction.

It is ideal for people wishing to learn new skills with the ultimate goal of gaining employment.
