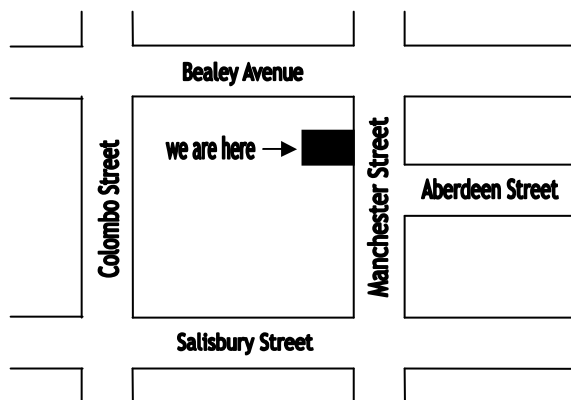

What you could achieve

The Academy assists every job seeker to set learning goals and plan steps to gain employment. When in employment support is given to ensure the transition to earning and independence is smooth.

All unit standard based learning gained from this programme is recorded with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority. These achievements remain with you forever and can be added to at any time.

WORKstart Horticulture includes

- Workplace Health & Safety requirements.
- An introduction to horticulture, where you'll learn all about botanical names, basic gardening techniques and tools, interpreting and monitoring weather information and documenting your work
- Horticulture, involving the properties of soil, the structure and functions of plants, preparing and sowing seedbeds and the use of chemicals for agricultural purposes
- Identification and control of weeds, plant pests, disease, disorders and their control
- Nursery techniques which includes plant propagation and plant seedlings

The WORKstart Horticulture programme offers skills, knowledge and a sound common-sense approach to working within the horticulture industry, while gaining a qualification (students who have not achieved the required credits for NCEA may be able to complete the qualification at Academy NZ).

It is ideal for people who enjoy working with their hands, gardening and working outdoors. Seize this opportunity to gain new skills that will assist you towards employment within this ever-growing industry!

We'll do more than teach you how to grow plants and interpret weather information - we'll also sit down with you to determine the skills and attitudes you need to get working!
