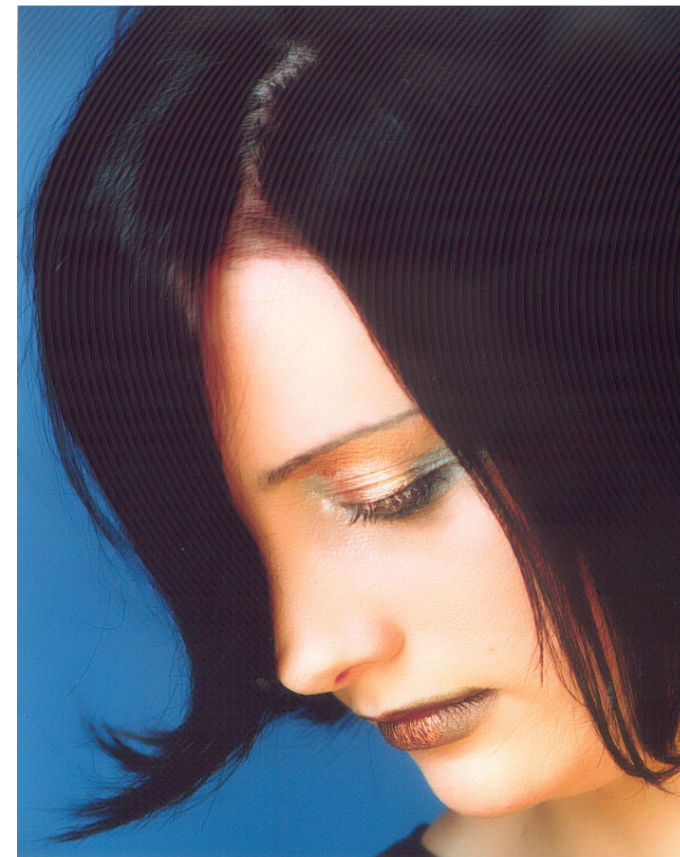
## Eligibility

It is vitally important that your reason for training with us is to get a job and that you are prepared to do what it takes to get that job!

Throughout this programme, you will be shown the skills needed to find employment successfully. This support is continued following the programme, with help finding employment or the appropriate next education programme to further your career.

As a part of your training, you will be placed into the industry for work experience. Many gain employment from this work experience.

You finish WORKstart when you gain employment (a maximum of 26 weeks training). However this may be extended in some instances for Youth Training job seekers.



## WORKstart is

- Practical hands-on training
- CV preparation or updating
- Work experience
- Career planning and job search
- Personal development to further enhance your skills for the workplace. You'll be able to develop essential attributes such as cultural and community awareness, time keeping, personal presentation, dealing with stress, team work and communicating in a working environment

## WORKstart offers

- Literacy and numeracy support
- NZQA units and/or qualifications
- Opportunity to complete NCEA up to Level 2

## What you could achieve

The Academy assists every job seeker to set learning goals and plan steps to gain employment. When in employment, support is given to ensure the transition to earning and independence is successful.

All unit standard based learning gained from this programme is recorded with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority. These achievements remain with you forever and can be added to at any time.

## WORKstart Salon Assistant includes

- An introduction to hairdressing, including fashion trends in hairdressing, using and maintaining the tools of the trade and knowledge of hairdressing trichology and the neutralizing process
- Salon Assistant skills which involve shampooing the hair and scalp, applying and removing colour from hair, applying treatments to the hair, blow drying and setting hair into simple styles and hair-ups
- Beauty services where you'll learn how to perform cosmetic make-up services, manicures and pedicures

We'll do more than teach you shampooing and styling tricks - we'll also sit down with you to determine the skills and attitudes you need to get working!

The WORKstart Salon Assistant programme offers career training in hairdressing, basic salon assistant skills, beauty services, customer services and sales skills while gaining a qualification.

It is ideal for people wishing to make a move into the hairdressing world.
