The Certificate in Floristry (Level 3) is a stepping-stone to a colourful floristry career. It will provide you with the essential skills needed in working with customers to create eye-catching, tasteful arrangements.

You'll learn the basic principles and elements of design, which include colour, form, texture and space, which can also be applied in a number of other creative professions.

Programme detail.

The following skills are covered in this programme:

- **Introduction to Floristry Skills:** Learning the different plants and foliage used in floristry, how to care for them, prepare them and display them.
- **Floristry Skills:** Applying the knowledge of products including artificial to advise customers; create a range of hand-tied designs such as posies and many types of bouquets, along with corsages and buttonholes; and learn about the principles of design.
- **Floriculture:** Gain knowledge about floriculture and how markets and auctions function in New Zealand and overseas.
- **Customer Service:** How to present a professional image, meet the needs of customers in all situations, give sensitive advice.
- **Retail Skills:** Create floral displays and prepare takings for banking.
- **Safety:** All aspects of working safely in a floristry environment including first aid.
- **Employment Skills:** Help in preparing for employment and looking for a job.
