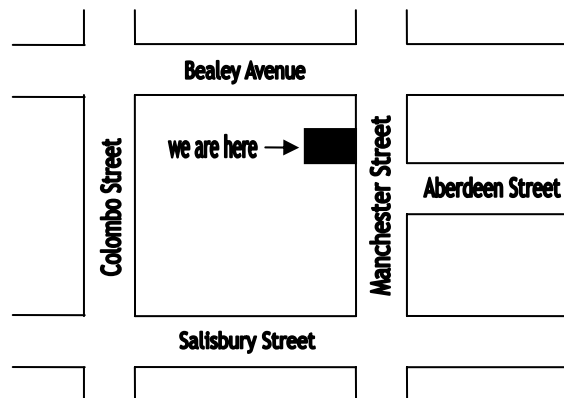

Why is STAR a good choice?

STAR (Secondary Tertiary Alignment Resource) offers students a chance to gain practical skills relevant to the industry and assist students to gain some insights into and explore potential career and further education options.

STAR allows students to see what a tertiary training establishment has to offer, by providing tertiary courses which will better meet the student's needs and motivate them to achieve and facilitate a smooth transition to further education, training and employment.

What does STAR provide?

STAR provides students with the opportunity to try out possible career choices and gain skills that are appropriate to the workplace and allows students to experience a different learning environment.

Through STAR, students have access to up-to-date industry specific knowledge and work-based learning. STAR programmes give students the opportunity to work towards the acquisition of unit standards on the National Qualifications Framework for vocational, education and training courses at level 1 or above.

STAR facilitates transition into the workplace for students, particularly those intending to go straight into the workplace without any formal qualifications.
